YADAC MEMO RE: WHITE DEER RUN- YORK ASSESSMENT CENTER

The purpose of this memorandum is to provide our local provider network clarification regarding the merger between White Deer Run York's Assessment Center and their new Outpatient Office in York; and to provide notice that LOCAs shall continue to be conducted at a YADAC contracted and approved Assessment Center.

- In partnership with White Deer Run of York-Outpatient, they will continue to provide free SCA LOCAs for uninsured and underinsured residents of central York County. Upon completion of the LOCA, individuals seeking treatment shall be referred to the provider of their choice for continued care.
- As outlined in our 2020-2021 provider contract, if the LOCA is unable to be conducted at a YADAC contracted and approved Assessment Center, the provider must document in the client chart the barriers and reasoning as to why. In the event the reasoning is determined to not be valid, the provider conducted LOCA may be denied payment by YADAC.
- Referrals for a LOCA may be made by contacting the White Deer Run of York outpatient office at 717-668-8035. It is important to note that when calling White Deer Run of York outpatient office to schedule the LOCA, they will answer as White Deer Run of York Outpatient. Please make sure that when calling them, you identify the request as a LOCA for an individual who has no insurance coverage.
- While associated with the White Deer run of York Outpatient, per YADAC and DDAP requirements the White Deer Run York –Assessment Center shall maintain neutrality when referring individuals into a specific level of care, a specific facility, or provider. This shall be monitored for compliance.
