I. Purpose:

To establish notification requirements to York/Adams Drug & Alcohol Commission of any contracted treatment provider reaching 90% capacity to admit persons who inject drugs (PWID).

II. Policy:

Contracted providers who treat PWID must notify the SCA within seven days upon reaching 90 percent of its capacity to admit individuals to the program for any reason, including depletion of funding allocation.

Notification shall occur as follows:

- Notification must be received via email;
- The notification must come from the provider director or their designee, and;
- Upon notification, the SCA will post the information on the Provider Portal of the SCA’s website to track and inform all appropriate entities of the capacity, and;
- The contracted provider must inform the SCA as described above when the capacity has lifted so that the website can be updated accordingly.
