

## WELCOME!

Apollo County Park was donated to the County in 1969 by P.H. Glatfelter Co., Inc. and named in honor of the 1969 Apollo Moon landing. Located east of New Bridgeville, Chanceford Township, Apollo County Park is three hundred and forty acres. The park features beautiful Hemlock and Tulip Poplar trees that are common there. The Mason-Dixon Trail traverses this park. In addition, several clear streams (Wilson Run and Boyd Run) cut through mountain laurel covered valleys on their way to the Susquehanna River.

## PARK ACTIVITIES

- **Trails** - Open to hiking, mountain biking and horseback riding. The parking lots are currently too small to accommodate horse trailers.
- **Fishing**- Fishing is permitted in the Susquehanna River as well as in Wilson Run. All Pennsylvania Fish & Boat Commission regulations apply.
- **Hunting**- Is allowed by Parks' Permit only. Contact the Administrative Headquarters for information concerning the permit.
- **Winter Activities**- Include cross country skiing & snow shoeing.

## DIRECTIONS

From Red Lion: Take Rt. 74 South to left on Burkholder Rd. Follow to New Bridgeville. Take Rt. 425 east 3.5 miles; --Turn left on Boyd Road. Travel 1.5 miles, parking lot is at end of the dirt road.

OR

--Continue on Rt. 425 east. Turn left on Shenks Ferry Rd. Parking lot on left.

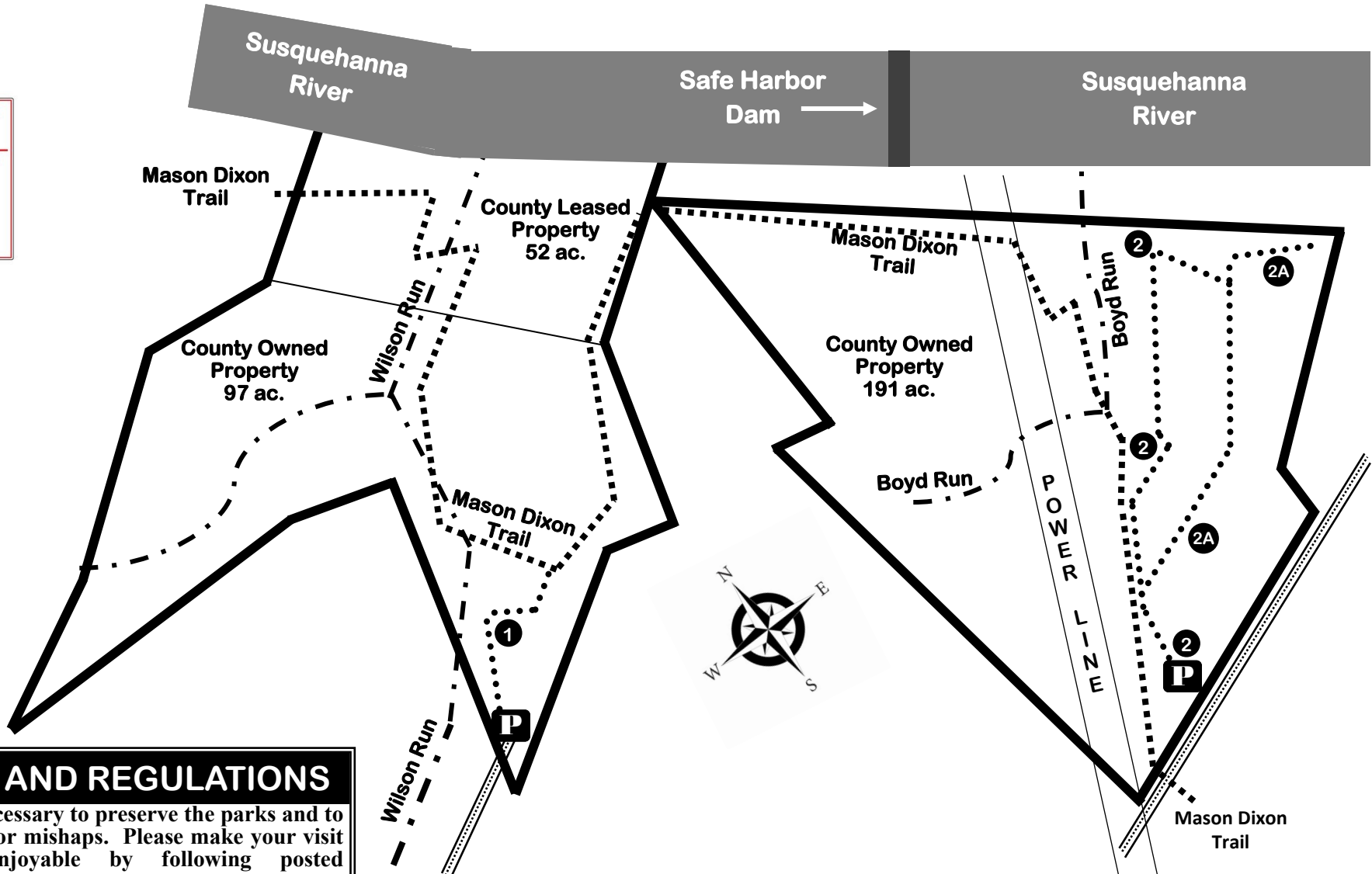

## RULES AND REGULATIONS

Rules are necessary to preserve the parks and to prevent visitor mishaps. Please make your visit safe & enjoyable by following posted regulations.

Emergencies or to contact a park ranger dial 911.

- Bikes and horses must stay on designated trails.
- Alcoholic beverages prohibited.
- Park is open dawn to dusk.
- Pets must be leashed.
- Wildlife/Plant life shall be left undisturbed.
- Additional info is posted at the parking areas.
- Motorized vehicles are prohibited, except in parking lots.
